Proposed title	The title is clear, specific, focussed and interesting.						
Thesis statement	Expresses the message of the essay and not the writer's intention. Indicates how the essay will proceed.						
Structure	It is clear that this is a discursive text and what information/arguments will be discussed.						
Purpose/ intention	It is clear what the writer wants to achieve and why.						
Context/ background	There is sufficient background information to establish the importance of this topic						
Attention/ interest	The writer has succeeded in making me interested enough to read further.						
Cautious language	The writer avoids huge claims which they will not be able to keep						
Register	The language used is suitably formal						
Coherence and cohesion	It is very easy to follow the writer's line of thinking						
Accuracy	There are no spelling, grammar or lexical mistakes
